Annual service standard check list:

Doors: Roller, sliding, folding, hinged manual or power operated and automatic.

Level One: (One visit per year)

- Functional test door and all systems
- Ensure entrapment preventions are in place
- Look for damage and excessive wear on parts
- Check alignment
- Check guards are in place and undamaged
- Ensure fire automation systems are operational
- Issue of paperless, electronic report

Level two: (Bi annually or more frequently as required)

- Some operational components are obscured within guards and covers requiring lifting equipment to access and carry out inspection. This would include roller doors where the roller is enclosed in a metal cover.
- This should be carried out at the start of an agreement and on an agreed frequency, based on usage and door type.

Additional services for power doors:

- Electronic pressure test on leading safety edge and record result
- Ensure all safety systems are in place and functional.
- Check presence safety override brakes on vertically operating doors, historically this was not required, it is now and is a retrospective legally require fitment.
- Maintain records of activity each door
- Complete report and submit
